## Sermon Summary

Reformation begins in our own individual hearts. It begins in your heart. Where is your heart this morning? Are you captivated that all of your hope is in Christ alone? Is your soul slumbering in light of all that's been given to us in Christ? My hope this morning (as it is every Sunday morning) is to direct your gaze to Jesus. Fix your eyes on him and him alone. We are going to take a look this morning at the fourth motto of the Reformation, *solus Christus* (in Christ alone). As we do, we will look at just three ways *solus Christus* impacts our hope from three different Scriptures. Though I hope to teach you of the truth of what Christ has done, my ultimate aim that you leave this morning loving Christ more. For those slumbering, I pray you'd awaken and give your lives to Jesus.

## Discussion Questions

- What was the most impactful moment from the message this morning?
- What are ways churches and Christians take their eyes off of Jesus? Why does our gaze seem to wander?
- How is it that Christ alone saves us? What's the danger if we forget that Christ alone saves us from sin?
- How does Christ provide purpose in suffering? How does he make the difficult journey of the Christian life worthwhile? Can someone in the group testify from their life this truth?
- How does Christ provide us with certain victory? How does Jesus give us hope even in death?
- What are some ways we keep Christ central in our church? In your home? In your life?
