Sermon Summary

As we contrast Jesus and Peter in the passage before us we will learn this important truth this morning: Jesus is faithful despite our unfaithfulness to him. Like Peter, we have denied Christ, rejected Christ, and abandoned Christ. Yet, even though we are so often unfaithful to Jesus, Jesus was faithful for us.

- What was the most impacting moment from the sermon?
- How was Jesus faithful before the Sanhedrin?
- How does Jesus' example of faithfulness encourage us to do the same?
- How can Christians today stand for the truth of the Gospel today?
- When we fail, why is it important to remember Christ's faithfulness on our behalf?
- In what way can you encourage one another to be faithful to Christ?
